The **General Terms and Conditions** apply to all mandatory grant programs. These Supplemental Terms and Conditions are additional requirements applicable to the program named below.

**APPLICABLE LEGISLATION, STATUTE, REGULATIONS**

1. The administration of this program is authorized under Title IV, Part B, Subpart 2, Section 430 to 439, of the Social Security Act (Act).
2. The program is codified at 42 U.S.C. §629 et. seq.
3. The program-specific implementing regulations are located at 45 CFR Part 1355 and 1357.
4. The Uniform Administrative Requirements, Cost Principles, and Audit Requirements for HHS Awards is located under 45 CFR Part 75. In accordance with 45 CFR §75.101 Applicability, this program must comply with 45 CFR Part 75 in its entirety. No exceptions were identified.
5. Additional applicable regulations and requirements can be found in the General Terms and Conditions for Mandatory: Formula, Block and Entitlement Grants.

**COST SHARING OR MATCHING (NON-FEDERAL SHARE) OF PROGRAM FUNDING**

6. The Federal Financial Participation (FFP) rate, per Section 434 of the Act, is **75 percent** of the amount expended for this program.
7. The States and Tribes are required to contribute the remaining **25 percent** of the total expended for this program. States and Tribes contribution may be in cash, donated funds, and non-public third party in-kind contributions. Except as provided by Federal statute, other Federal funds may not be used to meet the matching requirement. See 45 CFR §1357.32(d) for States and 45 CFR §1357.50(g) for Tribes.
8. *States only.* This program has a Maintenance of Effort (MOE) requirement, per 45 CFR §1357.32(f). A State may not use the federal funds under Title IV-B, Subpart 2, to supplant Federal or non-Federal funds for existing family preservation and family support services. For the purpose of implementing this requirement, "non-Federal funds" means State funds.

**FINANCIAL REPORTING**

9. Federal funds awarded under this grant must be expended for the purposes which they were awarded and

within the time period allotted.

10. States only. This program has an Administrative Cost requirement. According to Section 434(d) of the Act, States must limit administrative costs to 10 percent of the Federal funds.
11. The OMB approved Financial Reporting form for this program is the Financial Status Report SF-425. The SF-425 is due annually and no later than December 30, which is 90 days after the end of each project period.
12. Funding (project) period and obligation period. In accordance with 45 CFR §1357.32(g) for States and 45 CFR §1357.50(h) for Tribes, this program has a 2 year project/obligation period starting the first day of the Federal Fiscal Year, October 1, for which funds were awarded and ending the last day of the following Federal Fiscal Year, September 30. Any Federal funds not obligated by the end of the respective obligation period will be recouped by this Department.
13. Liquidation period. In accordance with 45 CFR §1357.32(g) for States and 45 CFR §1357.50(h) for Tribes, all obligated Federal funds awarded under this grant must be liquidated no later than the end of the funding/obligation period. Any Federal funds not liquidated by September 30 will be recouped by this Department.

## **PROGRAM REPORTING**

14. In accordance with 45 CFR 1357.16, the *Annual Progress and Service Reports* and *CFS-101* are required, no later than June 30. These reports must provide information on accomplishments and progress made during the previous fiscal year, and provides update on program areas selected for improvement and other activities in the next year. These annual reports must be submitted to the appropriate ACF Regional Program Office.

## **REAL PROPERTY AND TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY REPORTING**

15. The OMB approved Real Property and Tangible Personal Property Reporting is the following:
  - a. Real Property Reports (SF-429s). The SF-429 Real Property forms are not applicable to this program. Purchase, construction, and renovation are not an allowable activity or expenditure under this grant.
  - b. Tangible Property Report (SF-428s). The SF-428 Tangible Personal Property forms must be submitted as described in the General Terms and Conditions.

## **EFFECTIVE PERIOD**

16. These program-specific Supplemental Terms and Conditions are effective on the date shown in the footer at the bottom of the page and will remain in effect until updated. They will be updated and reissued only as needed whenever a new program-specific statute, regulation or other requirement is enacted or whenever any of the applicable existing Federal statutes, regulations, policies, procedures or restrictions is amended, revised, altered, or repealed.
